**Your pets qualify for free pet food if any of following screening criteria apply to you:**

- Paystub proving income is under government low income guidelines
- State or Federally funded welfare program
- Food Stamps
- Medicaid
- Social Security
- SSI Disability
- Unemployment

*Free dog and cat food (and kitty litter) will only be provided within the limits of the amount of dog and cat food donations received and funds available to purchase.*

**THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTATION WILL BE REQUIRED BEFORE WE CAN ACCEPT EVERY APPLICATION:**

1. Valid State Identification Card of Driver's License
2. Proof of Income (current pay, retirement, FS voucher, etc.)
3. Proof of Number of Pets (current vaccinations and/or pictures are preferred)
